

RELEASE AND LIABILITY WAIVER

If you are 18 years old or older, you must read and sign the following waiver before doing volunteer work with Lakeshore Baptist Church of Lakeshore, MS.

If you are under 18 years of age, a parent or guardian must read and sign the following waiver before doing volunteer work with Lakeshore Baptist Church of Lakeshore, MS.

This Release and Waiver of Liability (the "Release") is executed on the below dated, by the undersigned (the "Volunteer"), in favor of the Lakeshore Baptist Church of Lakeshore, Mississippi.

The Volunteer desires to work as a volunteer for the Lakeshore Baptist Church of Lakeshore Mississippi (hereafter Lakeshore Baptist Church) and engage in the activities related to being a volunteer (the "Activities"). The Volunteer understands that the Activities may include constructing, deconstructing, & rehabilitating buildings of Lakeshore, Mississippi, being transported to and from work locations, working at special events, and consuming food and living in accommodations provided for by Lakeshore Baptist Church in Lakeshore, MS.

The Volunteer hereby freely, voluntarily, and without duress executes this Release under the following terms:

- 1. Release and Waiver.** Volunteer does hereby release and forever discharge and hold harmless the Lakeshore Baptist Church and its successors and assigns from any and all liability, claims, and demands of whatever kind of nature, either in law or in equity, which arise or may hereafter arise from Volunteer's Activities with the Lakeshore Baptist Church. Volunteer understands that this Release discharges the Lakeshore Baptist Church from any liability or claim that the Volunteer may have against the Lakeshore Baptist Church of Lakeshore, Mississippi with respect to any bodily injury, personal injury, illness, death, or property damage that may result from Volunteer's Activities with the Lakeshore Baptist Church, whether caused by the negligence of the Lakeshore Baptist Church or its officers, directors, employees, or agents or otherwise. Volunteer also understands that the Lakeshore Baptist Church does not assume any responsibility for, or obligation to, provide financial assistance or other assistance, including but not limited to medical, health, or disability insurance in the event of injury or illness.
- 2. Medical Treatment.** Volunteer does hereby release and forever discharge the Lakeshore Baptist Church from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first aid, treatment, or service rendered in connection with the Volunteer's Activities with the Lakeshore Baptist Church.
- 3. Assumption of the Risk.** The Volunteer understands that the Activities may include work that can be hazardous to the Volunteer, including, but not limited to, construction, loading and unloading, and transportation to and from the work sites, and that food, accommodation, and medical facilities may be donated and beyond the control of the Lakeshore Baptist Church. Volunteer hereby expressly and specifically assumes the risk of injury or harm in these activities and releases the Lakeshore Baptist Church from all liability for injury, illness, death or property damage resulting from the Activities of the Volunteer's participation with the Lakeshore Baptist Church.
- 4. Insurance.** The Volunteer understands that, except as otherwise agreed to by the Lakeshore Baptist Church in writing, Lakeshore Baptist Church is not obligated to and does not carry or maintain health, medical, or disability insurance coverage for any Volunteer. Each Volunteer is expected and encouraged to arrive with medical or health insurance coverage in effect.
- 5. Photographic Release.** Volunteer does hereby grant and convey unto the Lakeshore Baptist Church all right, title and interest in any and all photographic images and video or audio recordings made by the Lakeshore Baptist Church during the Volunteer's Activities with the Lakeshore Baptist Church, including any photographs or recordings.
- 6. Other.** Volunteer expressly agrees that this Release is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Mississippi, and that this Release shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Mississippi. Volunteer agrees that in the event that any clause or provision of this Release shall be held to be invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity of such clause or provision shall not otherwise affect the remaining provisions of this Release which shall continue to be enforceable.
